- i) To share information on standards and promote use of standards among various stakeholders.
- j) To advise on implementation of established standards and initiatives required for appropriate resources to be mobilized in supporting it at National Level.
- k) To provide inputs for evolving mechanism for feedback on the implementation of standards.
